OUR TEACHERS

ISZN instrument teachers are specialists on their instrument and are either native or proficient English speakers. Teachers are fully referenced and checked. You can find their bios on the following pages.

PRACTICE ROOMS

- Two fully-equipped practice studios are available for student use before during or after school. Each room has a piano, keyboards, guitars, basses, and amplifiers for use.
- Sign-up sheets are posted each week for students to reserve times on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Two fully equipped music classrooms may also be reserved for individual or group practices.

PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES

Students have the opportunity to perform on stage each semester to celebrate their learning and share their achievements.

Lessons will be invoiced once per semester, and there is a commitment of the semester.

This rate is very competitive for private music lessons in Zurich. It is in line with other music lesson offerings in the area and allows us to access outstanding professional teachers for ISZN student musicians.

HOW THE SYSTEM WORKS


- Students in grades 1-12 will have one 30, 45, or 60-minute lesson per week with a private instructor.
- Students have a fixed day and a rotating lesson time, unless lessons take place after school. This means that students are pulled from different classes each week to minimize academic impact. There is an agreement that students catch up on any missed work.
- Parents, teachers, and students will receive their lesson times at the beginning of each month, along with a monthly lesson notification via SchoolsBuddy.
- Instrument teachers pick up students from homeroom in Primary. Students in Secondary take ownership of their own lesson time.
- Students will need to have access to their own instruments for practice at home. Depending on the instrument, students may need to bring their own instrument to school for lessons.
- Instrument rental and purchase information is available from the ISZN Performing Arts Department. We can recommend local instrument providers.

ISZN students may sit practical and theoretical music exams with the prestigious ABRSM and RockschooL.

Both ABRSM and RockschooL exams award UCAS points for UK university entrance for the higher grades 6, 7, and 8.

These exams are also recognized by international universities and are an official document of learning. Music exams give focus for students and an “end goal” to achieve.

WHY IN SCHOOL TIME?

- There are many reasons why this system is advantageous. Often students are involved with clubs and activities after school and would not otherwise have access to instrument lessons.
- Parents and students find it more convenient than organizing after-school transportation to an off-site private lesson.
- ISZN has oversight into what is taught in the lessons and will support feeding students into school and local ensembles.
- There are various studies which conclude that students do not suffer academic loss through pull out instrument lessons; in fact, studies tend to prove an increase in academic results!



FAQ'S

Can I start / leave mid-semester?

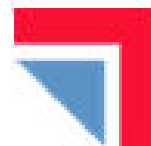
Once enrolled, the contract lasts for the semester. We can always start students mid-semester if there are is availability.

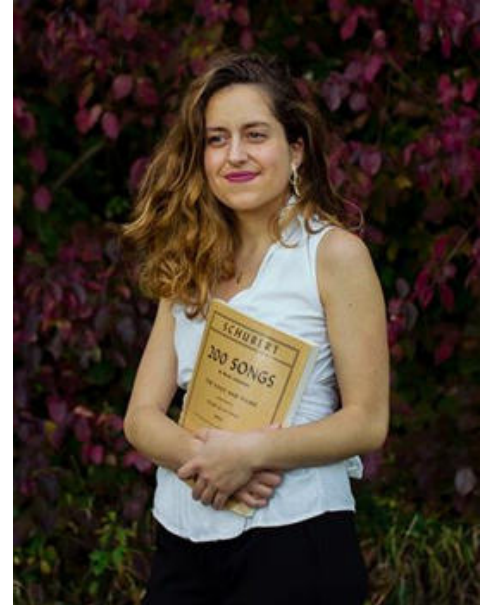
